Subject: Medi-Cal Rx Carve-out training available from Department of Health Care Services

Effective January 1, 2021, Medi-Cal pharmacy benefits will be administered by the Department of Health Care Services' (DHCS) new Medi-Cal Rx program. The Medi-Cal Rx program vendor is Magellan Medicaid Administration, Inc. (MMA).

DHCS is offering web-based instructor-led or computer-based training about Medi-Cal Rx through a Learning Management System (LMS), called Saba. All education and outreach events will be posted in a calendar on the Saba LMS.

To access the Saba LMS, providers will need to utilize the User Administration Console (UAC) application – a registration tool that controls and manages the user's access to the Medi-Cal Rx web portal and associated applications – available at <u>https://medi-calrx.dhcs.ca.gov</u> (the Medi-Cal Rx Provider Portal).
