## Subject: Sales tax reminder

In accordance with Medi-Cal billing and reimbursement guidelines, effective January 1, 2021, Blue Shield of California Promise Health Plan has been following the Medi-Cal guidelines regarding sales tax for incontinence, medical supplies, and durable medical equipment (DME).

For your reference and convenience, the information below has been excerpted from the Medi-Cal Provider manuals, which may be accessed online at: Incontinence Medical Supplies (incont) or \*Taxable and Non-Taxable Items (tax) (ca.gov) or Medical Supplies (mc sup)

For medical supplies: Items are reimbursable at the current provider county sales tax rate.

Excerpt from the mc sup manual: Sales tax on taxable items, such as medical supplies, is included in the Medi-Cal reimbursement. After the Medi-Cal allowable amount is computed, sales tax, at rates appropriate to the **county**, is added to the reimbursement. The determination of which items are taxable is made in accordance with Board of Equalization rules.

For incontinence supplies and DME: Items are reimbursable at the current California state sales tax rate.

- Excerpt from the tax manual: Claims for items subject to or exempt from California State sales tax must contain the proper HCPCS procedure code and modifier.
- For information about specific taxable and non-taxable items, please refer to \*Taxable and Non-Taxable Items (tax) (ca.gov) on the Medi-Cal website. Table 1 in this section lists the HCPCS codes that are subject to or exempt from California State sales tax.
