## **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

The 2022 Quality Program Evaluation documents the annual review and formal assessment of Blue Shield Promise Health Plan's Quality Improvement Program for Medi-Cal Los Angeles. This evaluation serves as the foundation for the ongoing quality improvement activities described in the 2022 Quality Work Plan and conforms to the 2022 Quality Program Description.
