

HEDIS Provider Guide: Postpartum Care (PPC- Postpartum)

Measure Description

A postpartum visit or pap test on or between seven (7) and 84 days after delivery.

Documentation

The medical record must include a note with the date that the postpartum visit occurred and one of the following:

- Pelvic exam.
 - o Evaluation of weight, blood pressure (BP), breasts and abdomen.
 - o Notation of "breastfeeding" is acceptable for the "evaluation of breasts" component.
- Notation of "postpartum care", "PP check", "PP care", "6-week check", or pre-printed "Postpartum Care" form in which information was documented during the visit.
- Perineal or cesarean incision/wound check.
- Screening for depression, anxiety, tobacco use, substance use disorder, or preexisting mental health disorders.
- Glucose screening for women with gestational diabetes.
- Documentation of any of the following topics:
 - o Infant care or breastfeeding.
 - o Resumption of intercourse, birth spacing or family planning.
 - o Sleep/fatigue.
 - o Resumption of physical activity.
 - o Attainment of healthy weight.

Using Correct Billing Codes

Global billing or bundled codes do not provide specific date information to count toward this measure.

How to Improve HEDIS® Scores

- Schedule your patient for a postpartum visit or pap test within 7 to 84 days from delivery.
- Send frequent appointment reminders by phone or text messaging.
- Telehealth visits can be completed for a postpartum care exam.
- Discuss and provide long term options for contraception during postpartum visit.
- Screen patients for depression within seven (7) to 84 days from delivery. Schedule the patient for followup within 30 days if depression screening is positive.
- Remind parents to schedule all well-child visits and vaccinations.
