Online services

Telehealth appointments

PIH Health physicians can conduct telehealth appointments for certain conditions using the patient portal.

A telehealth appointment is just like a regular appointment. You will see yourself and your provider on the screen of your mobile device or computer once your session begins. These appointments are also known as virtual visits.

PIH Health Patient Portal

You have plenty of reasons to register for the PIH Health patient portal. The all-in-one personal record and online portal lets you access your medical information on the go. You can:

- Manage your healthcare 24/7 from your computer or your mobile device.
- Request prescription renewals.
- Communicate privately with your physician's office via secure messaging.
- Access forms and information.
- View clinical summaries of your doctor visit or hospital stay.
- Track vital information such as height, weight, and blood pressure.
- View and print test and lab results.

- Create proxy accounts for children or dependent adults.
- Create and track wellness goals with online apps that let you monitor your health.
