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Subject: COVID-19 All Plan Letters – APL 20-022 vaccination requirement revisions

The Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) has issued several All Plan Letters (APLs) to Medi-Cal managed care plans (MCPs) in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. Recently, APL 20-022 was revised with recommendations regarding COVID-19 vaccination requirements. We are sharing a summary of these APL guidelines with you to ensure you are aware of the information.

Blue Shield of California Promise Health Plan (Blue Shield Promise) also publishes other COVID-19 information, some of which pertains to network Medi-Cal service providers.

APL 20-022

COVID-19 Vaccine Administration

Updates include:

- A third dose of the Pfizer or Moderna COVID-19 vaccine, taken at least 28 days after the second dose, is recommended for people with moderately or severely suppressed immune systems.
- A booster shot of the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine, take at least six months after the completion of the primary series, is recommended for individuals aged 65 and older, residents in long-term care settings, and individuals aged 50-64 with underlying medical issues.
- Individuals aged 18-49 with underlying medical conditions and individuals aged 18-64 who have an increased risk of COVID-19 exposure or transmission due to their occupational or institutional setting may also receive a booster Pfizer vaccine shot at least 6 months after their primary series, based on their individual risk and benefit.

Two updates relate to amended public health orders:

- <u>Vaccination</u> requirements for visitors to long-term and acute settings have been amended to include adult and senior care residential facilities.
- The definition of "workers" at adult and senior care facilities has been expanded, thus expanding the requirement for who must be vaccinated by November 30, 2021.
