## **PURPOSE**

To establish a standardized process which delineates the appropriate procedure for a provider to supply additional information to the Blue Shield of California Promise Health Plan (Blue Shield Promise) Utilization Management (UM) Department for reconsideration of a denial, deferral and/or modification to a Treatment Authorization Request when notified of such a determination.

## **POLICY**

A provider will have the ability and a mechanism to furnish Blue Shield Promise Health Plan with additional information/documentation which may have a bearing on the final determination of a request for authorization that has been previously denied, deferred, and/or modified.

## **PROCEDURE**

- 1. A provider requesting a reconsideration may call in, fax over or submit in writing any additional information to the Blue Shield Promise Health Plan Utilization Management Department to support the original authorization request.
- 2. A reconsideration request will occur within one business day upon receipt of the provider telephone call or a written request.
- 3. The case manager shall review the additional information and present it to the Blue Shield Promise Health Plan Medical Director or designated peer reviewer.
- 4. If the Blue Shield Promise Health Plan Medical Director or designated peer reviewer reverses the original determination based on additional information provided by the provider, the case will be closed.
- 5. If reconsideration does not resolve a difference of opinion, the provider may then submit an appeal grievance in writing to the Blue Shield Promise Health Plan UM Department.
- 6. This policy will be reviewed and revised annually and approved by the Medical Services Committee and the Board of Directors.
