- Sexual Transmitted Infection (STI) screening
- Contraceptive prescribed

How to Improve HEDIS® Scores

- Perform Chlamydia screening every year on every 16 to 24-year-old female identified as sexually active (use any visit opportunity).
- Add Chlamydia screening as a standard lab for women 16 to 24 years old. Use adolescent wellcare exams and well woman exams for this purpose.
- Ensure that you have an opportunity to speak with your adolescent female patient without her parents present.
- Remember that Chlamydia screening can be performed through a urine test. Offer this option for your patients.
- Request a focused list of members who need chlamydia screening from your Blue Shield Promise Quality Program Manager.

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
