

HEDIS Provider Guide: Childhood Immunizations (CIS)



Measure Description

Children 2 years of age who had the following vaccines **on or before their second birthday:**

- 4 DTaP (diphtheria, tetanus and acellular pertussis)
- 3 IPV (polio)
- 1 MMR (measles, mumps, rubella)
- 3 HiB (H influenza type B)
- 3 Hep B (hepatitis B)
- 1 VZV (chicken pox)
- 4 PCV (pneumococcal conjugate)
- 1 Hep A (hepatitis A)
- 2 or 3 RV (rotavirus)
- 2 Flu (influenza)

How to Improve HEDIS® Scores

- Use the California State Immunization Registry (CAIR) to register immunizations: <https://cair.cdph.ca.gov>
- Review a child's immunization record before every visit and administer needed vaccines.
- Recommend immunizations to parents. Parents are more likely to agree with vaccinations when supported by the provider. Address common misconceptions about vaccinations.
- Have a system for patient reminders.
- Some vaccines may have been given before the patients were Blue Shield Promise members. Transcribe these vaccinations into CAIR even if your office did not provide the vaccine.
- Request a focused list of members who need to complete the childhood immunizations series from your Blue Shield Promise Quality Program Manager.
