Access and convenience

SeaView IPA makes it easy to access care when you need it.

- A primary care physician (PCP) who leads your medical team and directs the medical care for you and your family members
- 24/7 access to your PCP or an on-call physician when your PCP is unavailable
- Seven urgent care centers with extended hours and weekend access, for an alternative to ER visits for non-emergency care

Service and support

With a PCP referral, SeaView IPA members have access to facilities and programs to provide extra health and wellness support.

- Anticoagulation Clinic: Provides professional health services through anticoagulation assessments.
- Diabetes Clinic: Develops individualized treatment plans, collaborates with other healthcare professionals and maintains detailed records.
- Ambulatory Case Management: Provides telephonic education and support to maintain health and better manage existing conditions.
- Transitional Care Program: Nurse practitioners and the PCP work together to create a treatment plan and supervise health care.
